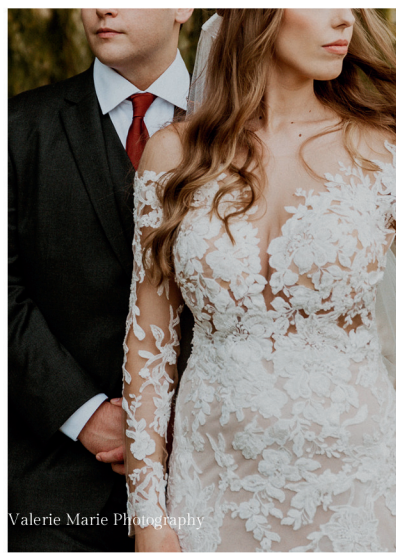

ABOUT THE CUISINE

From the very first pour to the final late-night bite, the evening was designed as a layered culinary experience that unfolded effortlessly throughout the celebration — all thoughtfully crafted and prepared by The Timberlodge’s in-house culinary team. Cocktail hour set the tone with an abundant Butchers Board Grazing Table, inviting guests to mingle over artisan cheeses, cured meats, and thoughtfully curated accompaniments.

Taking center stage at the bar were two signature cocktails that immediately became conversation pieces — the bright “Vivi-Rita Margarita” and the smooth “Luffy Whiskey Sour,” named after their cats. Together, they brought personality and playful charm to the evening.

Dinner embraced rich, comforting flavors elevated with thoughtful detail. Braised chuck roast offered deep, slow-simmered richness, paired with heritage pork carved to perfection. Crispy sea salt smashed potatoes and aged cheddar mac & cheese added indulgent warmth, while oven-roasted broccolini with toasted garlic brought balance and brightness to the plate. The result was a refined yet inviting menu that felt perfectly suited to a cozy fall celebration at The Timberlodge.

For dessert, the couple shared a cranberry orange cake for their ceremonial cut, alongside an abundant cupcake display for guests to enjoy.

As the evening continued, late-night stations brought playful energy with a fire-roasted s’mores bar at the fire pit, hot pretzels, a tater tot and french fry bar, and a flatbread pizza station — the perfect finale to a night filled with warmth, flavor, and celebration.

about The Timberlodge at Arrowhead

Q. WHAT IS THE MAXIMUM CAPACITY OF YOUR VENUE?

The Timberlodge is an intimate yet spacious venue, with both indoor and outdoor seating. The capacity of the space seated comfortably is 220 with a head table. With seating on the connected patio, we can accommodate 250-280 guests. There is plenty of room, both inside and outside, to celebrate with all of your family and friends!

Q. WHAT TIME WILL I HAVE ACCESS TO THE VENUE AND HOW LATE CAN WE GO?

A. Our suites are complimentary 2 hours prior to your start time. If you would like to come onsite earlier, you can get all day access to the bridal suite as early as 10am for an additional charge. After a busy day filled with lots of love and lots of dancing, your music and bar must end by 11:00pm due to the town noise ordinance. The entire length of your reception depends on how many hours of bar you purchase.

Q. WHERE ARE THE CLOSEST HOTELS?

The Timberlodge is located in Akron, New York, with several hotel options available within a 15–25 minute drive. Most nearby accommodations are located in Williamsville, Amherst, and the Buffalo Airport area, offering a range of well-known hotels, dining options, and convenient amenities for wedding guests.

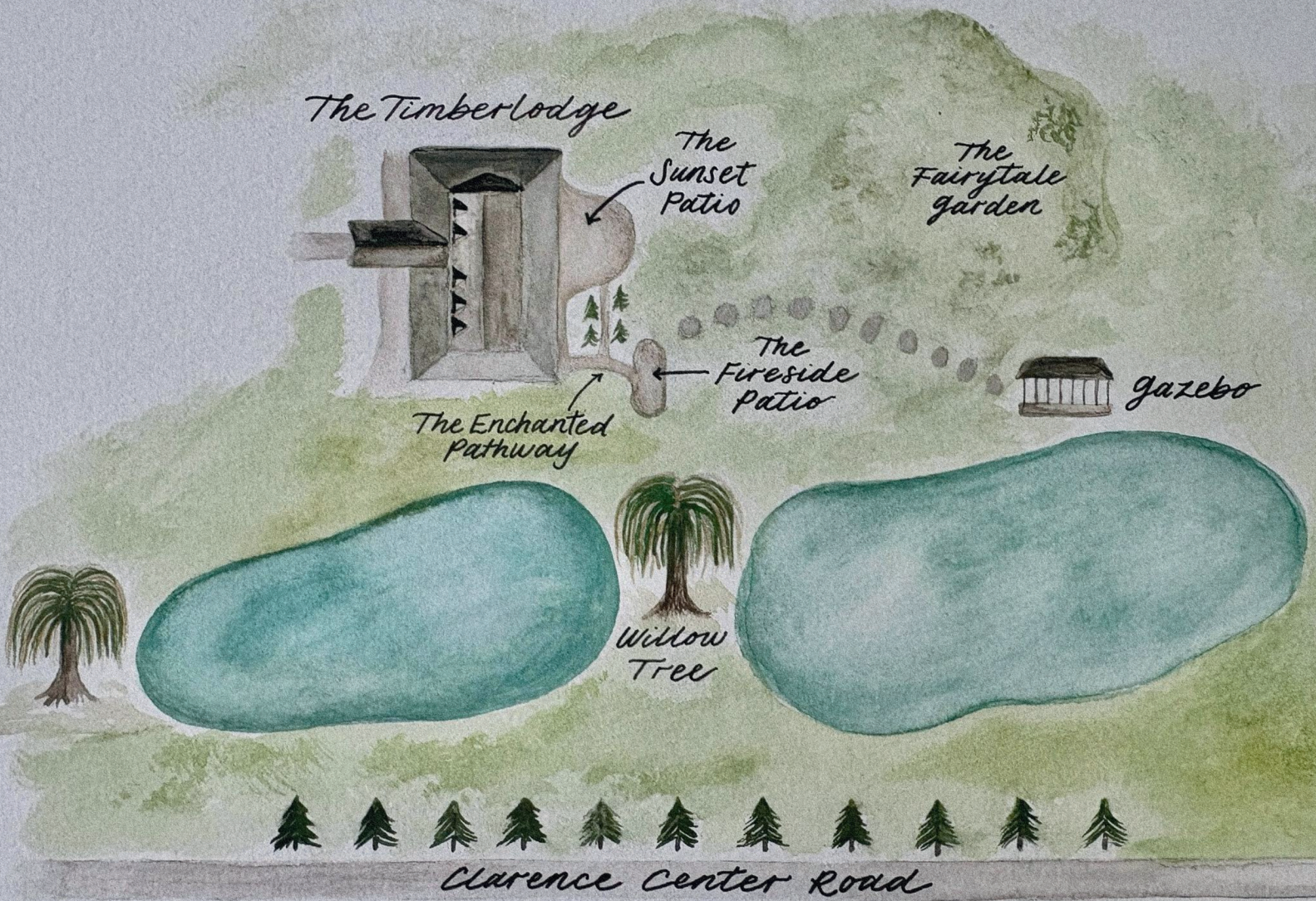

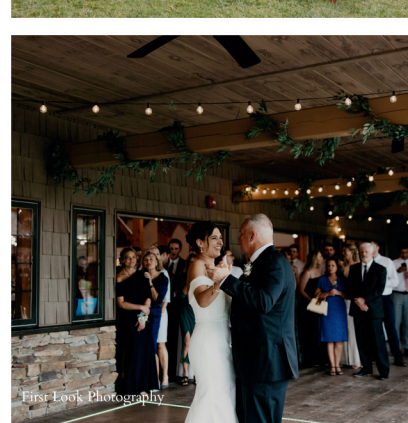
